She also served as the Director of Events and oversaw the Affiliate's 45,000+person Race for the Cure® and other Affiliate events, bringing in more than \$2 million annually.

A highlight for Becca was seeing a flood of pink t-shirts coming into Downtown Columbus every year and knowing that for one morning at least, families affected by breast cancer could walk side-by-side with others and find comfort and strength in numbers.

Through working with non-profit clients within her first role as Account Manager for Paul Werth Associates and following an impactful college internship with Habitat for Humanity in Athens, Ohio, Becca's love for non-profit work, community building, and grassroots outreach became and continues to be a focal point for her career.
