Ohio Senate Government Oversight and Reform Committee Chairperson Manchester, Vice Chair Brenner, Ranking Member Weinstein, and Members of the Senate Government Oversight and Reform Committee:

My name is Johonna Hughes and I am a parent from Franklin County. I am here today to urge you to restore the Governor's budget proposal, which included critical investments for a child tax credit.

Keeping consistent child care has been a struggle because of my own job turnover. Every time I lose a job or have to switch positions, it disrupts the care my children receive. That instability affects them emotionally and developmentally—and it weighs heavily on me as a mom.

My family is struggling financially—it feels like I'm constantly drowning and can't stay afloat. I'm stuck in a cycle of dead-end jobs without benefits, and dealing with government assistance is a constant hassle.

Past decisions I made over five years ago still limit my job opportunities. Even though I have multiple certifications, I'm not able to use them fully. I haven't been able to finish college, and minimum wage just isn't enough to survive while raising four children.

I take full accountability for my past and continue working hard to be a productive member of society. But the ripple effects are real—and my kids feel them too. I just want the opportunity to build stability for my family. Real support would make a huge difference.

Groundwork Ohio has outlined key priorities that will strengthen our state's early childhood system, including:

- Child Care Crisis: RESTORE publicly funded child care eligibility to 160% of FPL and RESTORE the Child Care Choice Voucher program to \$75M in FY26 and \$150M in FY27.
- Economic Stability: RESTORE the proposed refundable Child Tax Credit of up to \$1,000 per child under age 7.

These investments will not only help children thrive but also boost Ohio's workforce and economy. I urge you to fully fund these initiatives to ensure every child gets the best start in
